To Our Residents, Families, and Team Members:

Next week, we will begin holding our first vaccine clinics in several Caraday communities. Caraday is working with CVS Health through the federal government's Pharmacy Partnership for Long-Term Care Program to provide COVID-19 vaccinations for our residents and team members. Senior care residents and workers have been identified as top priorities for receiving access to the vaccine.

The clinics are being scheduled by CVS, who will be administering the Pfizer vaccine. This vaccine is given as two separate doses, 21 days apart. Thus far, the following dates have been confirmed:

December 28

Sagebrook Nursing & Rehabilitation, 10am - 4pm (second dose on 1/20)

January 4

Park Bend Health Center, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 1/25)

January 8

Wurzbach Nursing & Rehabilitation, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 1/29)

January 11

Stonebridge Health Rehab, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 2/1)

Weston Inn Nursing & Rehabilitation, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 2/1)

January 13

Temple Living Center West, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 2/3)

January 14

Western Hills Nursing & Rehabilitation, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 2/4)

Windcrest Nursing & Rehabilitation, 10am - 5pm (second dose on 2/4)

As updates and additions to the schedule are made, we will share them with you.
